Holy Trinity Catholic Parish Concerning Funeral Quick Reference Sheet Spring 2026

Funeral Masses or Memorial Times:

Funerals are celebrated at 10:00am, Monday through Friday only.

No Eulogies at Funeral Mass:

According to Diocesan policy, if family members wish to offer eulogies, they should do so during the wake. #382 of the General Instruction for the Universal Church states: At the funeral Mass there should as a rule be a short homily, but never a eulogy of any kind.

Visitations and receptions are not available in the church:

Holy Trinity does not currently have the means and space available to allow outside receptions in our parish hall. Additionally, visitations are not allowed in the church narthex before or after the funeral Mass.

Choosing of 1 Reader and Gift Bearers:

Holy Trinity Parish utilizes one reading before the Gospel, which the family picks with Parish Communications. One reader from the family is asked to read this. The family is also asked to have 2-3 people from the funeral party bring up the gifts during the Preparation of the Gifts.

Choosing Music Selections:

The Parish Communications Office will be in contact with the next of kin/family to assist in planning the music for the funeral. For frequently asked questions or to schedule a meeting (if needed), please contact the parish office at 630-968-1366 Ext. 120. Once all details are finalized, an email will be sent with the confirmed readings, music selections, and other important information.

Funeral Stipend Policy as of Spring, 2026

If working with a funeral home, stipends for the church and music director must be dropped off 24 hours before the day of the funeral. If the family is planning the funeral independently, stipends for the church and music director must be dropped off 48 hours before the day of the funeral.
